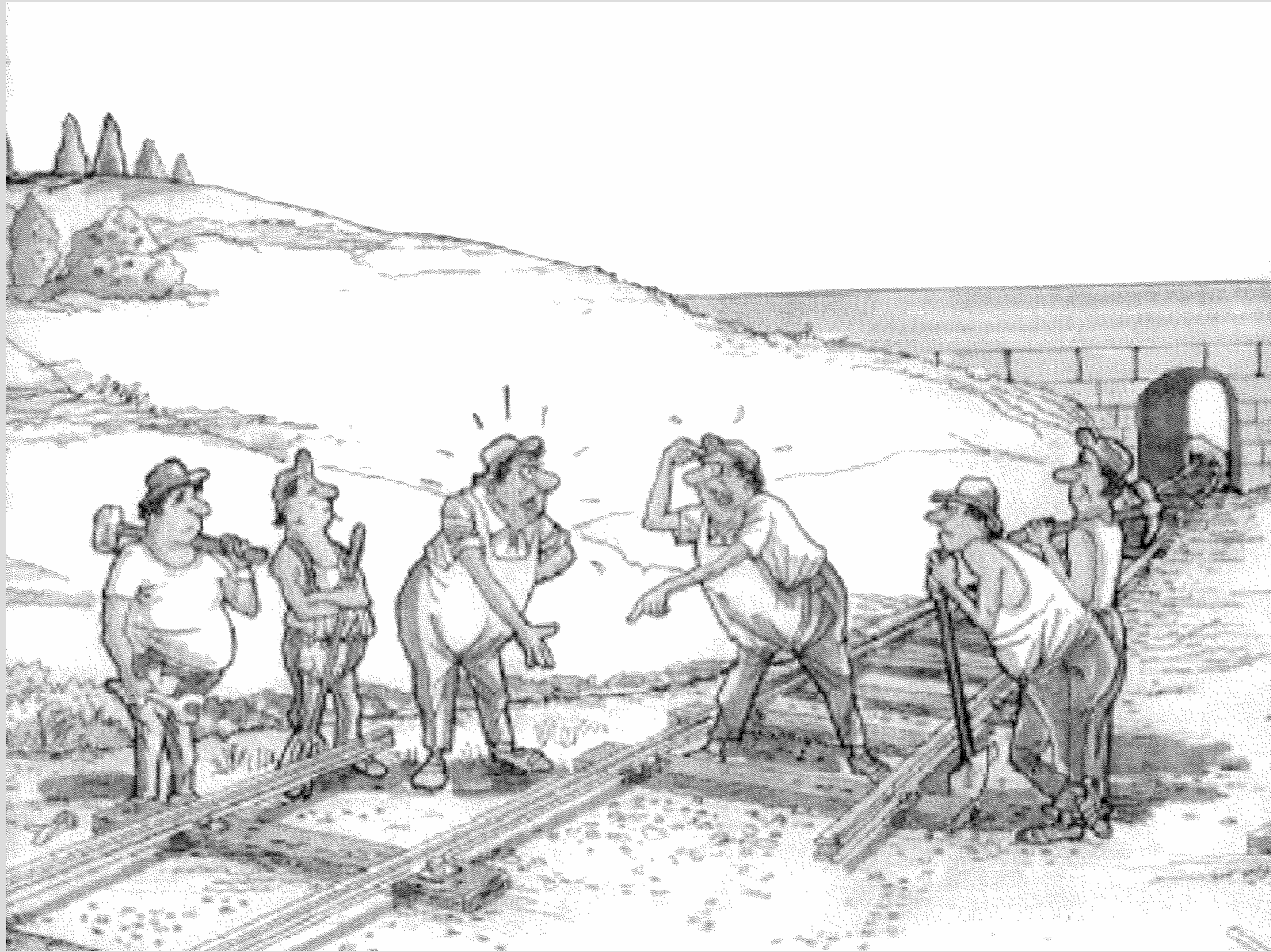

- Observance/ high trust
- ODF

Policy on open document formats:

- ODF but not exclusive
- reading and saving
- no quantitative targets
- support and community (open doc society)
- due date april 1 2008
[13 ministries]
- Other public organisations follow ultimo 2008

Further action on OSS

OSS is preferred if usage is equally suitable

- implementation strategies ministries
- as well as for local governments and the semi public sector
- supporting front runners
